INFORMATION ON HOW TO APPLY FOR DRIVING PRIVILEGES WITH THE OAKWOOD MUNICIPAL COURT

- 1. You can apply for driving privileges if you license is under a BMV suspension for Non-compliance (FRA), or a twelve (12) point suspension. If you have additional suspensions, you cannot apply for privileges. You must clear those suspension prior to applying.
- 2. You must have an Ohio license or a temporary ID. You cannot obtain driving privileges on a permanent ID card.
- 3. Required "Hard" Suspension time has EXPIRED:
 - a. 1st offense FRA Suspension within 5 years Cannot apply for privileges for the fifteen (15) days of the suspension.
 - b. 2nd or more offense FRA suspensions within 5 years Cannot apply for privileges for the first thirty (30) days of the suspension.
- 4. You must reside in Montgomery County.
- 5. A petition must be completed, available at court.oakwoodohio.gov or at the Court.
- 6. A filing fee is required to file the petition (see the fee schedule on our website, or call the Court). Check or cash is the only form of payment accepted.
- 7. You must attach the following documents with your petition when filing:
 - Current auto insurance (must show dates of coverage)
 - Letter from your employer (on company letterhead) stating location, days and hours of work
 - School schedule, with location, days and hours of classes
 - Medical appointments or scheduled treatment information

NO DRIVING PRIVILEGES ARE GRANTED FOR ANY COMMERCIAL MOTOR VEHICLE FOR WHICH A CDL IS REQUIRED (4506.161 ORC).
